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## **WORKS UPDATE FOR LAST WEEK**

- Northern façade of Atlantic House tidied up & a clean cut has been made post demolition works, in anticipation for the new superstructure.
- Scaffold has been complete to the eastern elevation of Lytham House ready for infill works and façade tidy up next week.
- Infill works to eastern façade of Lytham House has commenced. Anticipated 12/04/24 completion date.
- Two floodlights have been installed in the site compound area.
- Movement monitoring visit complete.
- Dust, Noise & Vibration monitoring on-going daily via MYCO's monitoring stations on site.

## UPCOMING WORKS FOR W/C 02/04/24

- Underpinning due to commence in Atlantic & Lytham House.
- Commencement of the contiguous pile wall is set to commence w/c 15/04/24. A 48-hour notice period will be given prior to the pilers start onsite.
- Civils works due to start 04/04/24 for our temporary builder's supply (TBS). This will be within our hoarding and adjacent to St. Albans Grove.
- Concrete wagons will be pulling into site daily with underpinning set to commence, approximately 2nr wagons per-day, onsite for 20 minutes each.
- Movement monitoring on-going.
