#### WORKS UPDATE FOR LAST WEEK

- The fourth set of underpins in Lytham House were poured 09/05/24.
- Imported 21 loads of stone.
- Steel erection for the façade retention commenced, fitting steel beams on the east elevation of Lytham House.
- Movement monitoring visit completed, no issues.
- Dust, Noise & Vibration monitoring on-going daily via MYCO's monitoring stations on site, no issues.

### UPCOMING WORKS FOR W/C 13/05/24

- Underpinning within Lytham House continued with a concrete pour set for Thursday 16/05/24.
- Arrival of demolition plant (highreach). The movement order for this machinery has been rescheduled for 13/05/24, with the scheduled arrival time on site at 05:00. The early delivery of plant is due to road safety. If this date / time changes, this will be communicated to all local residents immediately. All works will be in conjunction with the CTMP.
- Steel erection for the façade retention continued, fitting steel beams on the remaining three elevations and levels.
- Movement, Noise, Vibration and Dust monitoring ongoing.
