## WORKS UPDATE FOR MAY

- Underpinning of the existing foundations in Lytham House continued.
- Demolition of the eastern façade of Atlantic House was completed with all demolition plant collected from site.
- Façade retention continued, with all external steel beams installed.
- Crane base enabling works had been completed.

## **UPCOMING WORKS FOR JUNE**

- Groundworks in Atlantic House to commence.
- Tower crane installation scheduled for the 29/06/24 and 30/06/24. All works will be in conjunction with the traffic management plans which have been approved by RBKC.
- Demolition of the roof and third floor of Lytham House scheduled for w/c 17/06/24. This work does not involve any demolition plant and will be demolished with hand-tools.
- Internal façade retention on ground floor to floor two continued.
- Structural strengthening of Atlantic House continued.
- Demolition scaffold to the eastern façade of Atlantic House will be struck.
