WORKS UPDATE FOR LAST WEEK

- The seventh set of underpins in Lytham House were poured on 23/05/24.
- Plant for crane base enabling works collected on 28/05/24 and 30/05/24.
- Scaffold crash deck to Atlantic house commenced.
- Exported stone away from site throughout the week.
- Steel erection for the façade retention continued.
- Movement monitoring visit completed, no issues.
- Dust, Noise & Vibration monitoring on-going daily via MYCO's monitoring stations on site, no issues.

UPCOMING WORKS FOR W/C 03/06/24

- Underpinning within Lytham House to continue with a concrete pour scheduled for Thursday 06/06/24.
- Groundworks in Atlantic House to continue, including reducing the ground level in Atlantic House, pouring new pad foundations, and setting drainage.
- Steel erection for the façade retention continued, fitting steel beams on the remaining three elevations and levels.
- Groundworks for crane base to commence.
