WORKS UPDATE FOR LAST WEEK

- Internal demolition of Lytham House has been completed, in line with the programme.
- Crane has continued its lifting operations, the crane has zonal restrictions, meaning it can only lift within the parameters of our site, and there is no oversailing.
- Stone and muck produced from groundworks removed from site continued as planned.
- Drainage & waterproofing works continued in Atlantic House, preparing for the first section of the basement slab to be poured w/c 02/09.
- Movement, Dust, Noise & Vibration monitoring ongoing daily via MYCO's monitoring stations on site, with no issues to report.

UPCOMING WORKS FOR W/C 02/09/24

- Groundworks in Lytham House to recommence, now demolition has been completed.
- The first delivery of steel for Atlantic House will arrive on site 02/09.
- Scaffolding will continue on the eastern end of Atlantic House, for our steel frame erection.
- Movement, Noise, Vibration and Dust monitoring ongoing.
