
Atlantic House

WORKS UPDATE FOR LAST WEEK

- Steel erecting in Atlantic House had continued.
- Crane has continued its lifting operations, the crane has zonal restrictions, meaning it can only lift within the parameters of our site, and there is no oversailing.
- Stone and muck produced from groundworks removed from site continued as planned.
- The fourth steel delivery had arrived onto site on the 23/09/24.
- Drainage & waterproofing works continued in Atlantic House.
- Bricklayer started in Atlantic House, commencing façade infill works.
- Metal decking for Atlantic House slabs arrived 26/09/24.
- Groundworks in Lytham House continued, with a second concrete pour completed on 23/09/24.
- Movement, Dust, Noise & Vibration monitoring ongoing daily via MYCO's monitoring stations on site, with no issues to report.

UPCOMING WORKS FOR W/C 30/09/24

- Groundworks in Lytham House to continue, with a concrete pour scheduled for 26/09/24.
- The steel delivery for Lytham House Atlantic House will arrive on site 30/09/24.
- Bricklayer will continue the façade infill works.







- Façade restoration works will commence on Lytham House 23/09/24.
- Steel erection in Lytham House will commence.
- Movement, Noise, Vibration and Dust monitoring ongoing.
