WORKS UPDATE FOR MARCH

- Crane has continued its lifting operations, the crane has zonal restrictions, meaning it can only lift within the parameters of our site, and there is no oversailing.
- All roofing membrane has been laid to Atlantic House and Lytham House.
- Steel erection in Link Building completed.
- Façade works (SFS) continued in Atlantic House.
- M&E containment & ducting has continued in Atlantic House and Lytham House.
- Internal partitions have progressed well in Atlantic House and Lytham House.
- Brick work to North and East elevations have progressed
- Timber Window installation to Lytham House has been completed.
- Aluminium window installation to Atlantic House has commenced.
- Façade restoration to Lytham House and painting has almost completed.
- Underfloor heating and screeding has completed in Lytham House. Works have now commenced in Atlantic House

UPCOMING WORKS FOR APRIL

- Window installation in Atlantic House will complete.
- Substation fit out works will complete. Transformer will be delivered in April.
- Façade works (SFS) will complete on the Link Building.

- M&E containment & ducting will continue in Atlantic & Lytham House.
- Insulation & Screed will complete within Atlantic House.
- Brickwork will continue on the North and East Elevation.
